CONDITIONS OF USE

- **The charge for a 12 month residents' beach season ticket commencing from 11th January 2016 is £110.00** and no refunds will be issued after the commencement date.
- Season tickets will only be issued with one registration number displayed.
- The owner/keeper of the vehicle must be resident at the applicant's address. It is the holder's responsibility to ensure that the ticket is clearly shown on the vehicle that is parked in the car park.
- This ticket cannot be used for a vehicle that is parked and being used in connection with any Commercial Activity (Trading). A Traders Permit needs to be purchased for these vehicles.
- On display of the ticket on the windscreen of the vehicle, it may be parked without payment of the parking charges in the following car parks and on street locations. A season ticket does not guarantee a parking space and any other conditions for the car park will still apply.
 - * Banks Road (On Street)
 - * Branksome Chine
 - * Branksome Dene Chine
 - * Beach Road
 - * Brudenell Avenue and Road (Pay and Display area)
 - * Chaddesley-Glen Lower
 - * Haven Road
 - * Shore Road (Off and On street)
 - * Sandbanks car park and peninsular
 - * Western Road
- If the registration number on the season ticket needs changing, please contact the Parking Administration Section with details of the new vehicle. A new ticket will be issued on production of the required evidence and payment of £10.00. The old ticket has to be returned on receipt of the new season ticket.
- A vehicle displaying a season ticket which has been altered or tampered with, will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice.
- Photocopying a season ticket is deemed as misuse and will result in your season ticket being revoked.
- Penalty Charge Notices will be issued for failing to display the season ticket or a valid Pay and Display ticket.
- If your season ticket is stolen, a replacement will be issued on production of a crime number from the Police confirming the theft of the season ticket or vehicle. If your vehicle is written off and the season ticket lost, a replacement will be issued on receipt of confirmation of the write-off. **Season tickets lost in other circumstances will not be replaced.**
- Season tickets will not be issued for the following classes of vehicles: - heavy goods vehicles, buses, caravans and coaches or vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes (3,000 kg) in weight.
- There are bays specifically designed for "camper vans" in the Sandbanks and Beach Road car parks. Camper vans should always park within the parking space markings. Please be aware that you will be liable to receive a Penalty Charge Notice if your vehicle overlaps the markings.
